- Discourage unsportsmanlike behavior and dangerous play, but strongly promote players to demonstrate good sportsmanship, kindness and compassion in any situation.
- Abide by and support the rules of The PARC's recreational league.
- No matter what background, race, religion, walk of life, gender or disability/ability any of my players, coaches, parents or spectators may come from, they will be warmly welcomed to The PARC and will be treated kindly and fairly.

**As a PARC Official, all players shall be treated as individuals so I will provide the necessary patience and time to each player regardless of their skills or development.**

- Maintain a positive, supportive and Christ-Like attitude.
- Teach and demonstrate to all players and parents that good sportsmanship and fair play should be exhibited at all times regardless of victory or defeat.
- Use my influence as an official and leader to respectfully interact with parents and spectators so that I can effectively control the behavior of spectators and parents.
- Recognize that each child has a different skill level, so I will patiently teach each player based on their individual skills the proper etiquette and rules of the game.
- Provide an organized game that is fun, safe and shows good sportsmanship with all players and coaches involved.
- Arrive to my scheduled games in a timely manner and effectively communicate with PARC staff about any complications that may occur.
- Conduct the required pre-game and post-game prayer to promote the spiritual growth of the players and coaches during each game.
