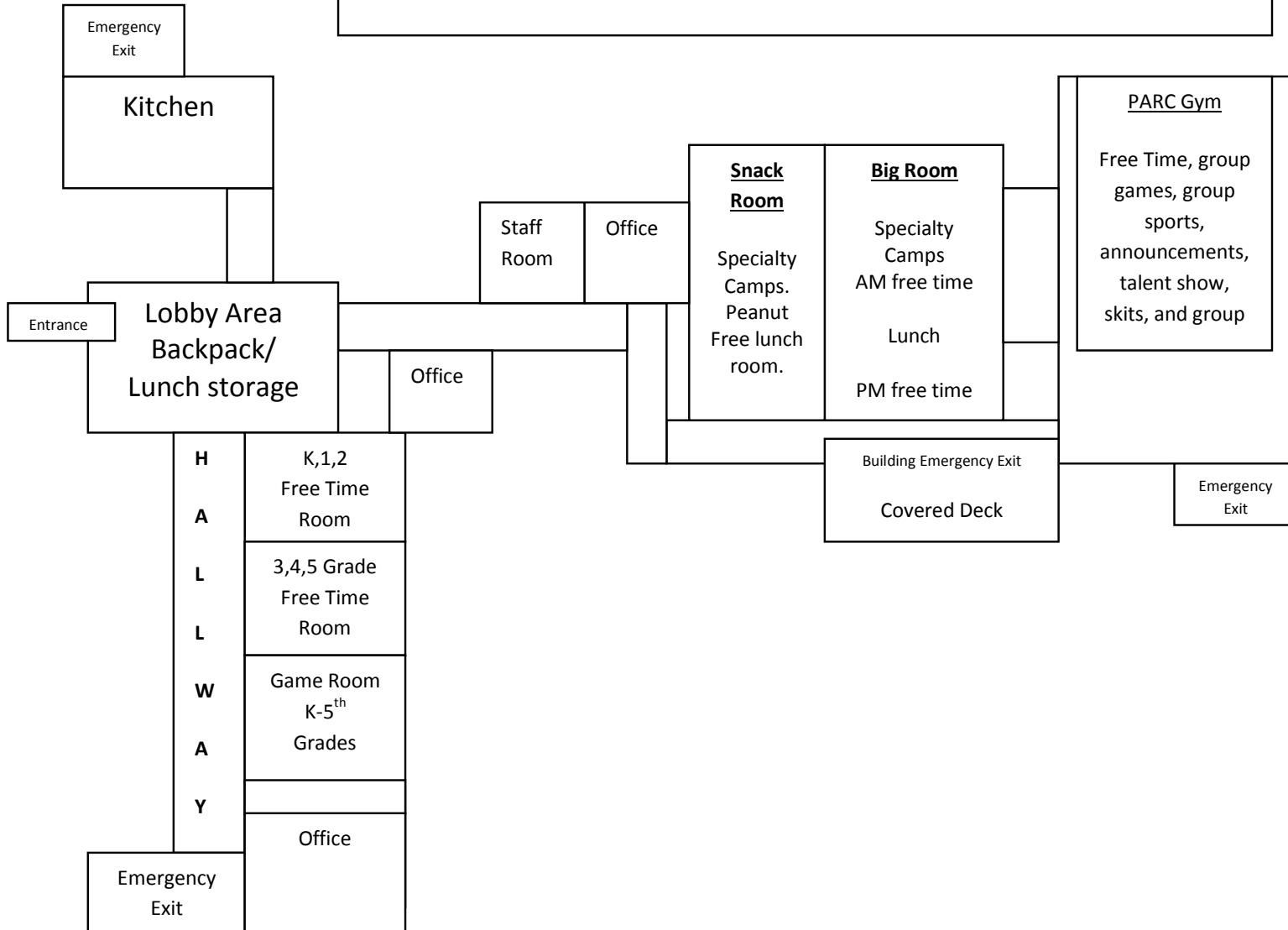

- Listed below are the specialty camps for the summer. Please see the calendar for each week for more information. Each week we will offer 4 specialty camps. Each child will pick a 1st and 2nd choice. Each specialty camp includes a field trip and a swimming day.
- Kitchen fun has a capacity of 12 children
- Science has a capacity of 12 children
- All other specialty camps will have a capacity of 20

- **Cooking Around the World:** Each week, the children will learn about a different food from another country or another part of the United States – limit 12 participants
- **Be the Scientist:** Work with your friends and a counselor to do outrageous science experiments with food, goo, and other fun items. Experiments will ooze, explode, fly, slide and glide.
- **Legomania:** Do you enjoy building with Legos? Kids will enjoy time building different models and using their imagination building with Legos. This is a fun camp that offers the kids opportunity to build and use their imagination.
- **Sports:** This camp is in the gym. It involves all different sports from basketball, kickball, volleyball, dodge ball, wacky sports and team sports. Children must wear tennis shoes to participate in this camp.
